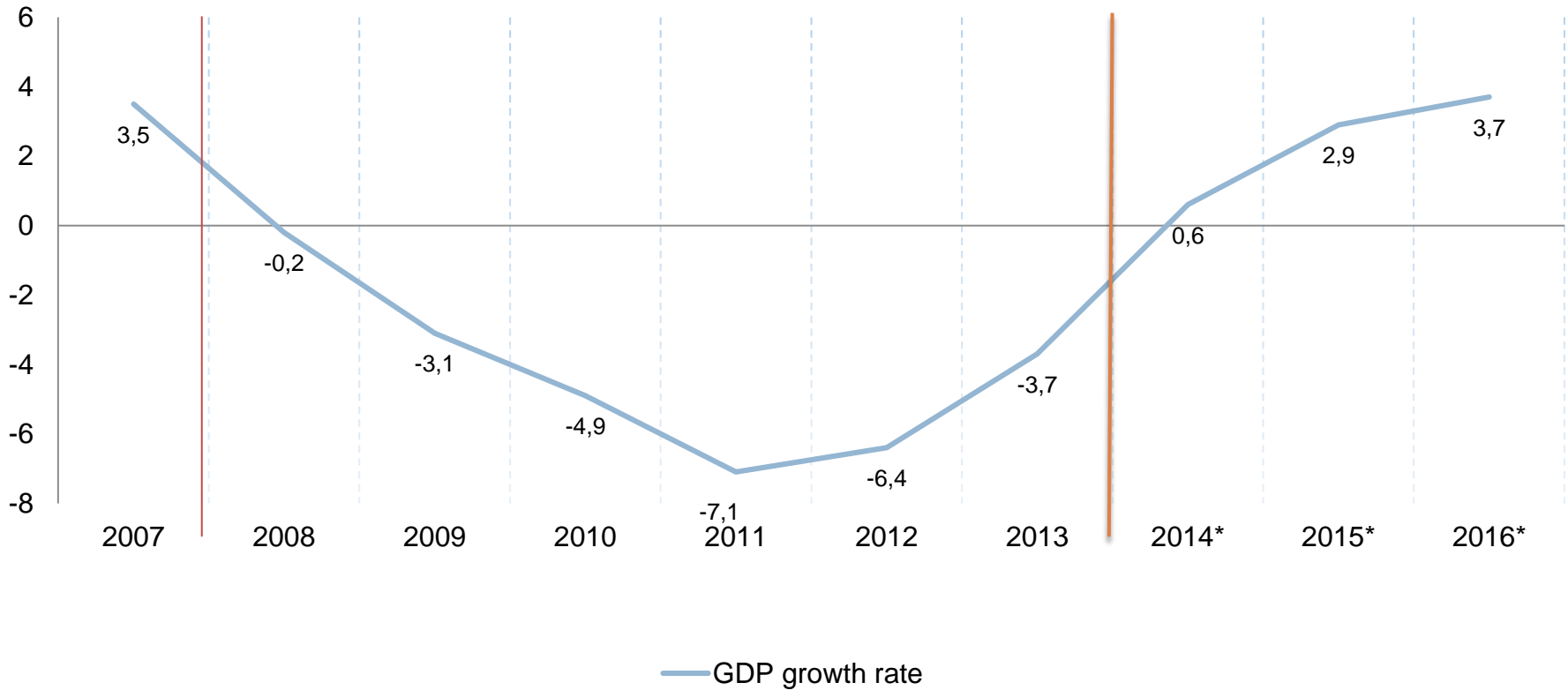

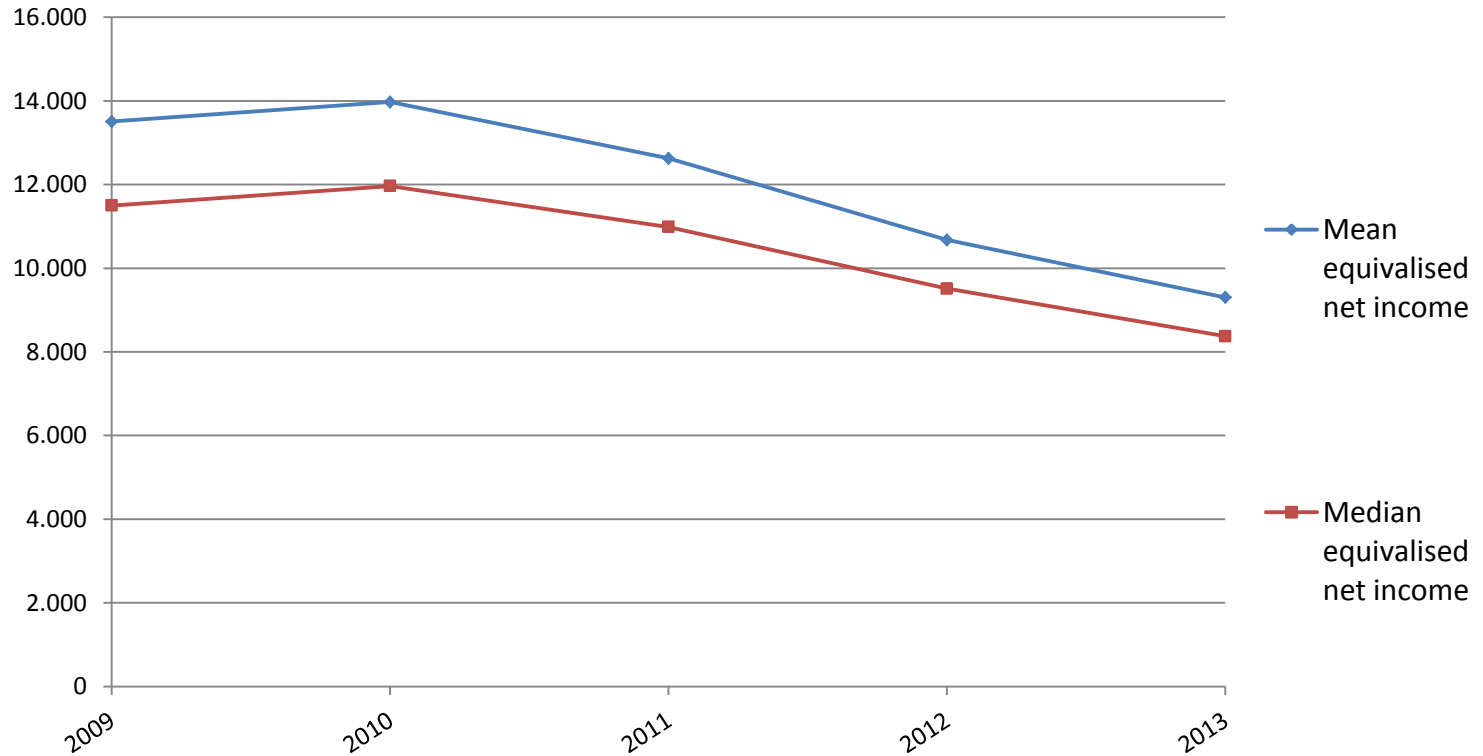


GDP Growth Rates in Greece (2007-2016)



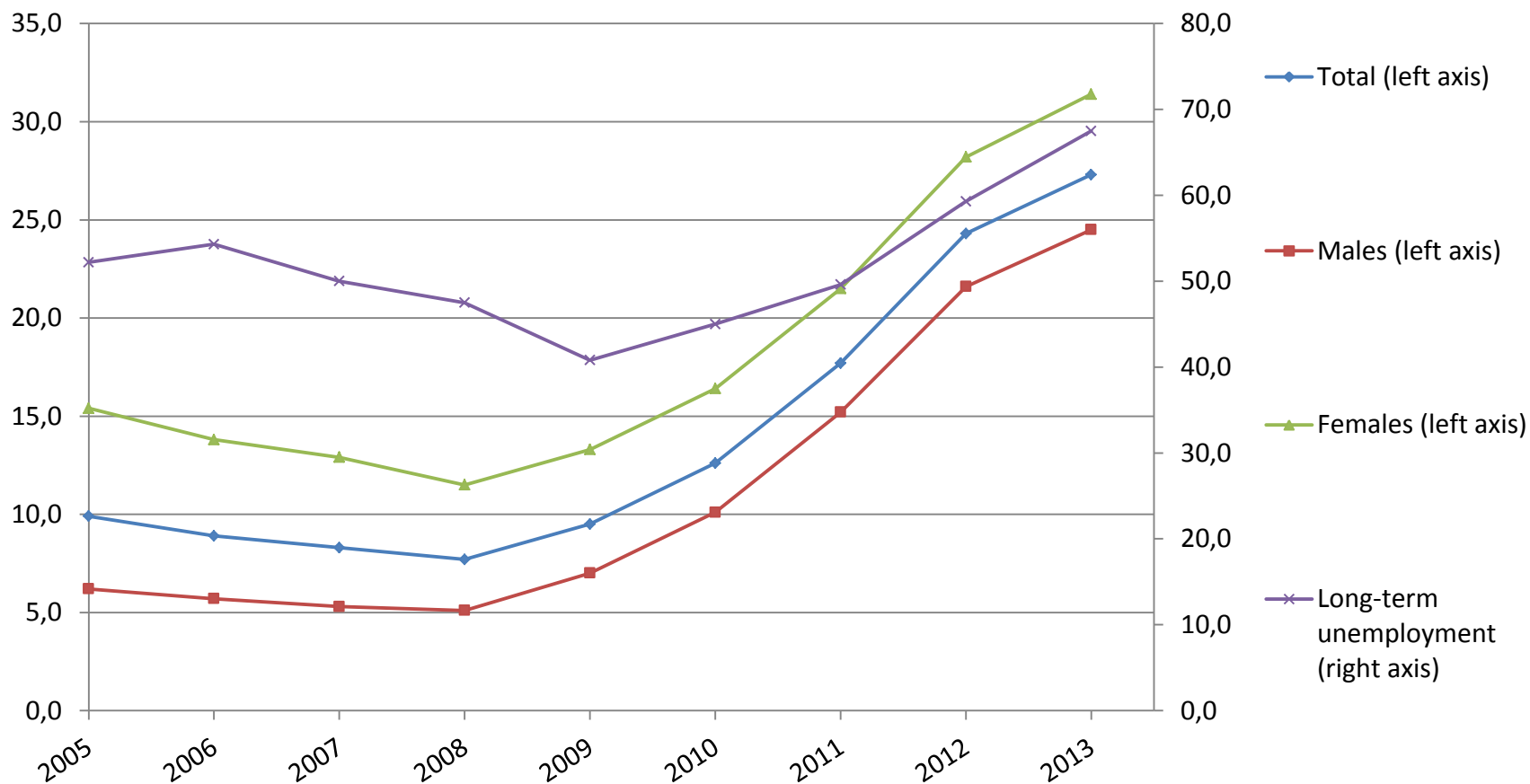

Mean and median net income, Greece (€, 2009-2013)



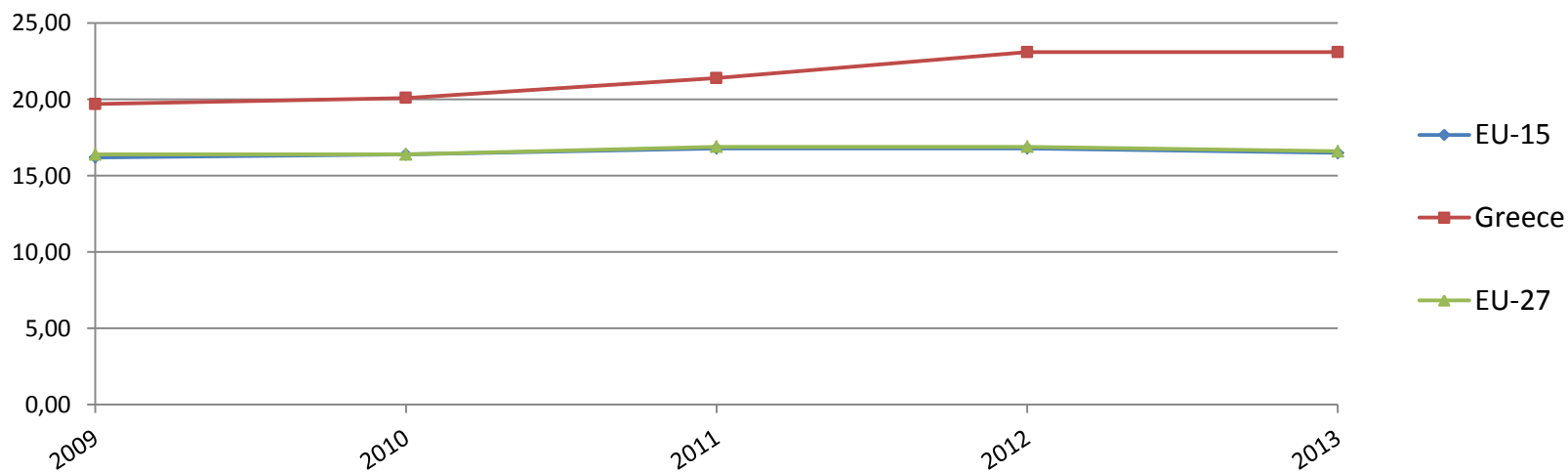
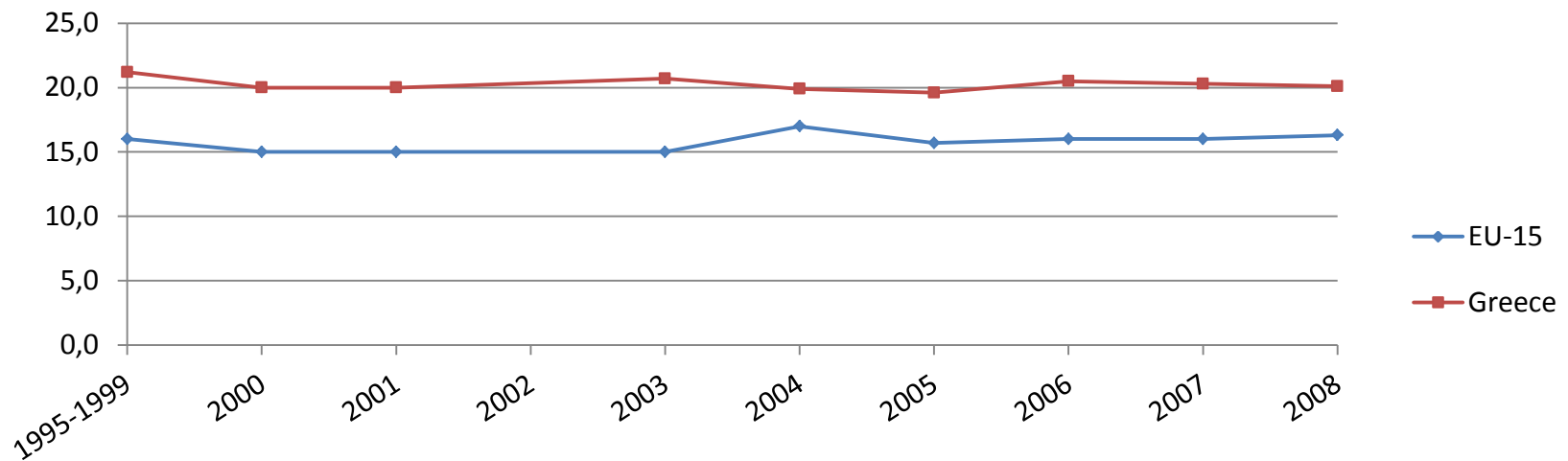

Unemployment, Unemployment by sex and long term unemployment, Greece (%, 2005-2013)

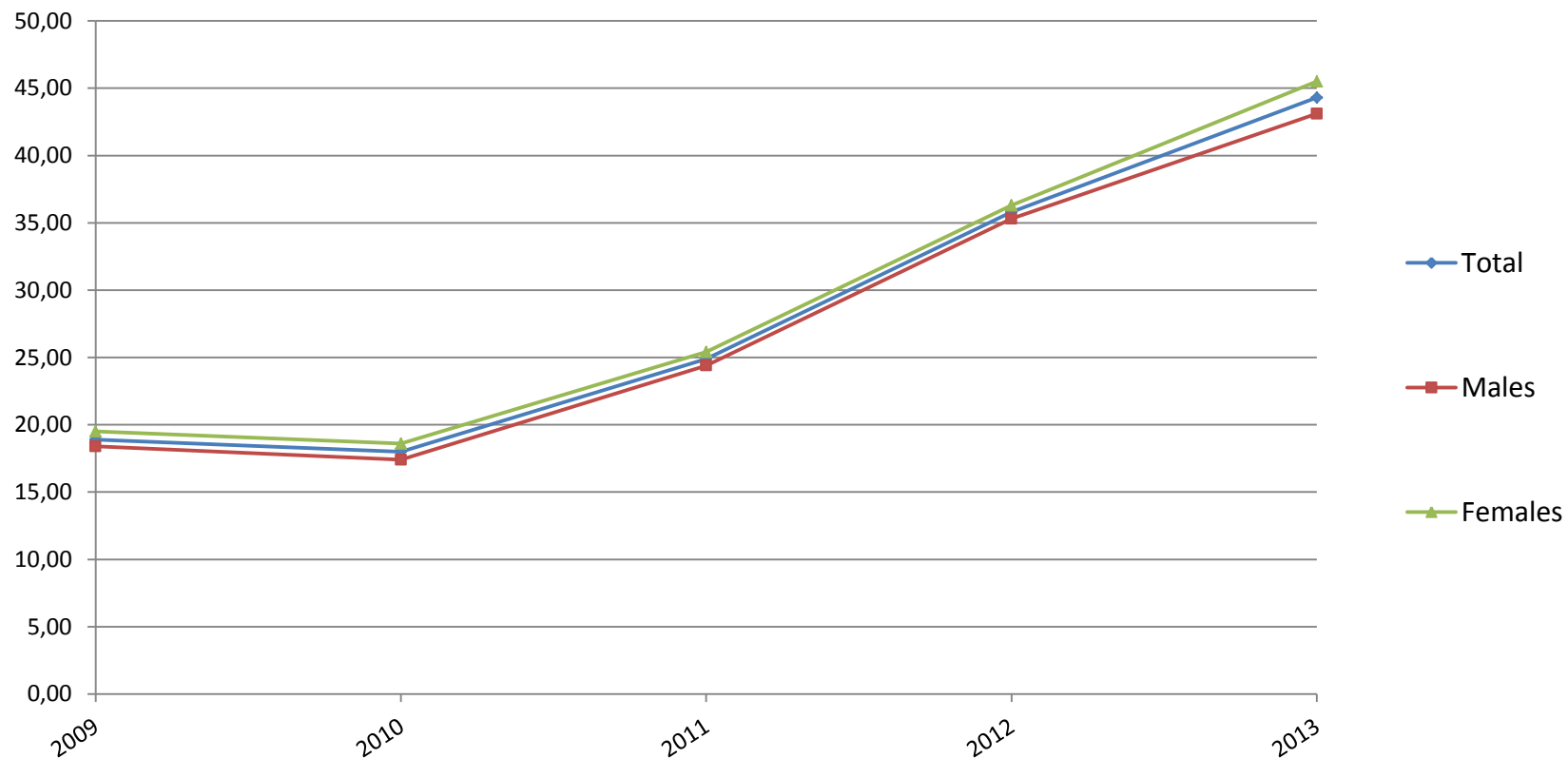

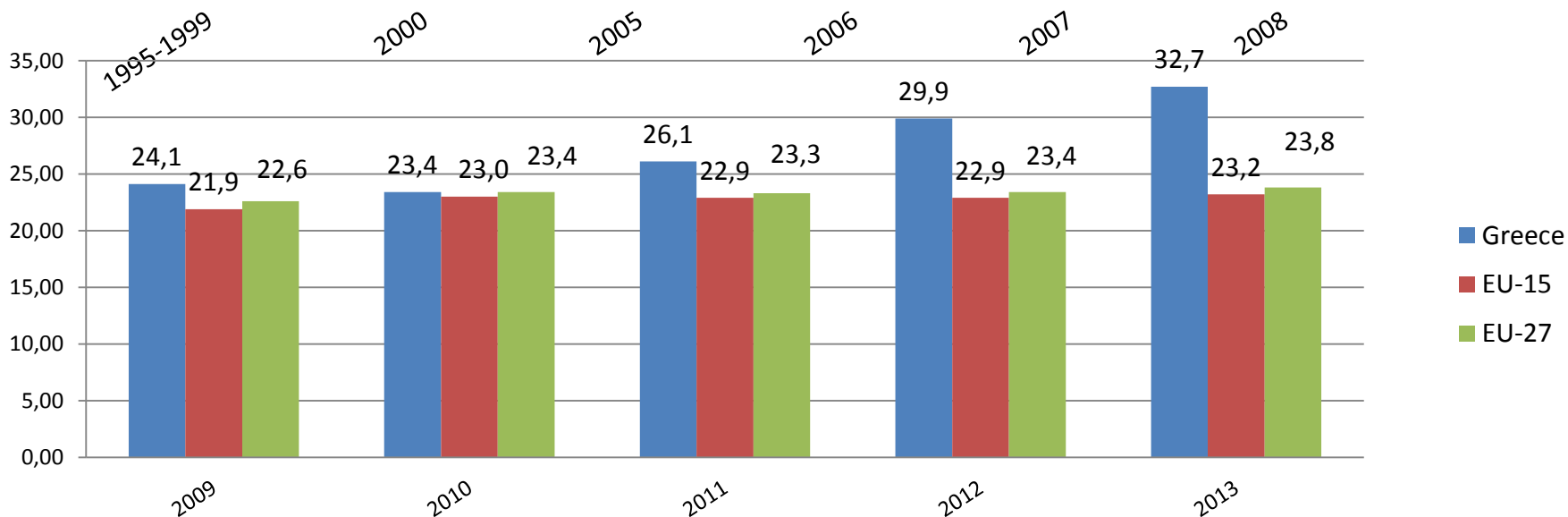
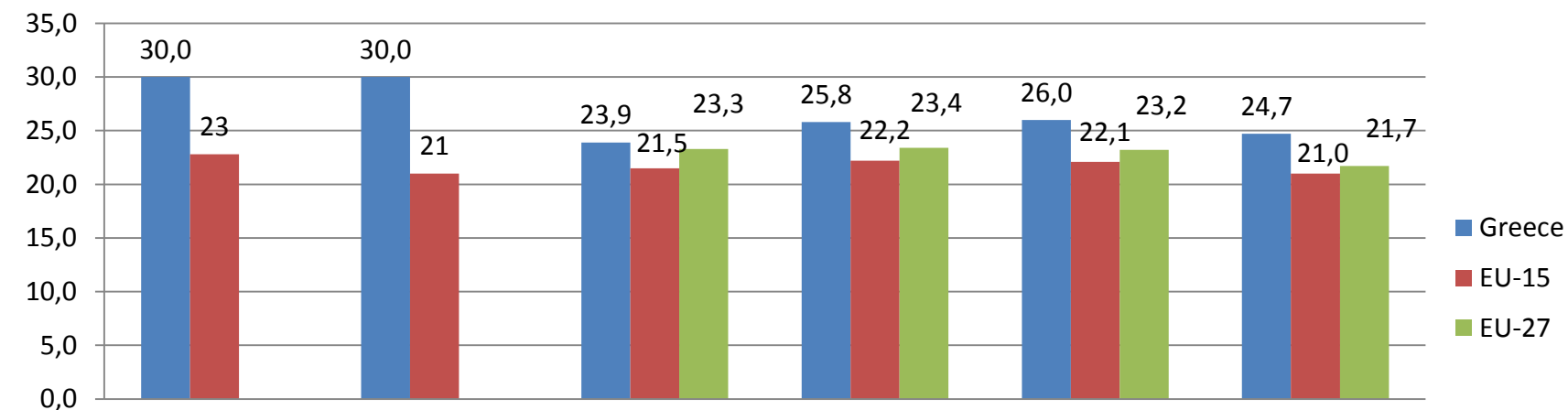
Risk of poverty, Greece, EU-15 (% , 1995-2008, 2009-2013)



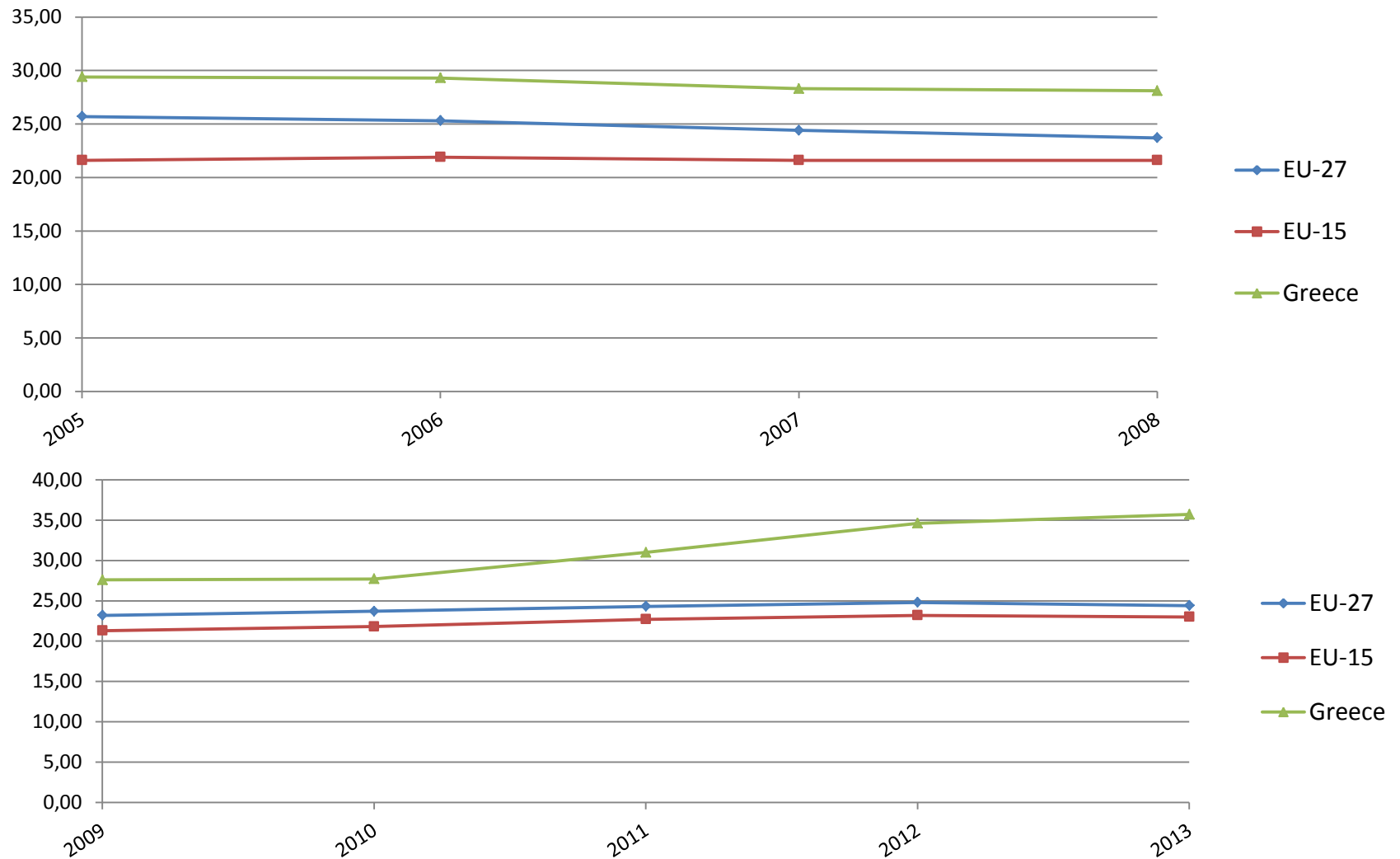
Poverty rates with a fixed poverty line, Greece (2009-2013, 60% median equivalised income 2007, adjusted for inflation)



Poverty gap, Greece, EU (% , 1995-2008, 2009-2013)

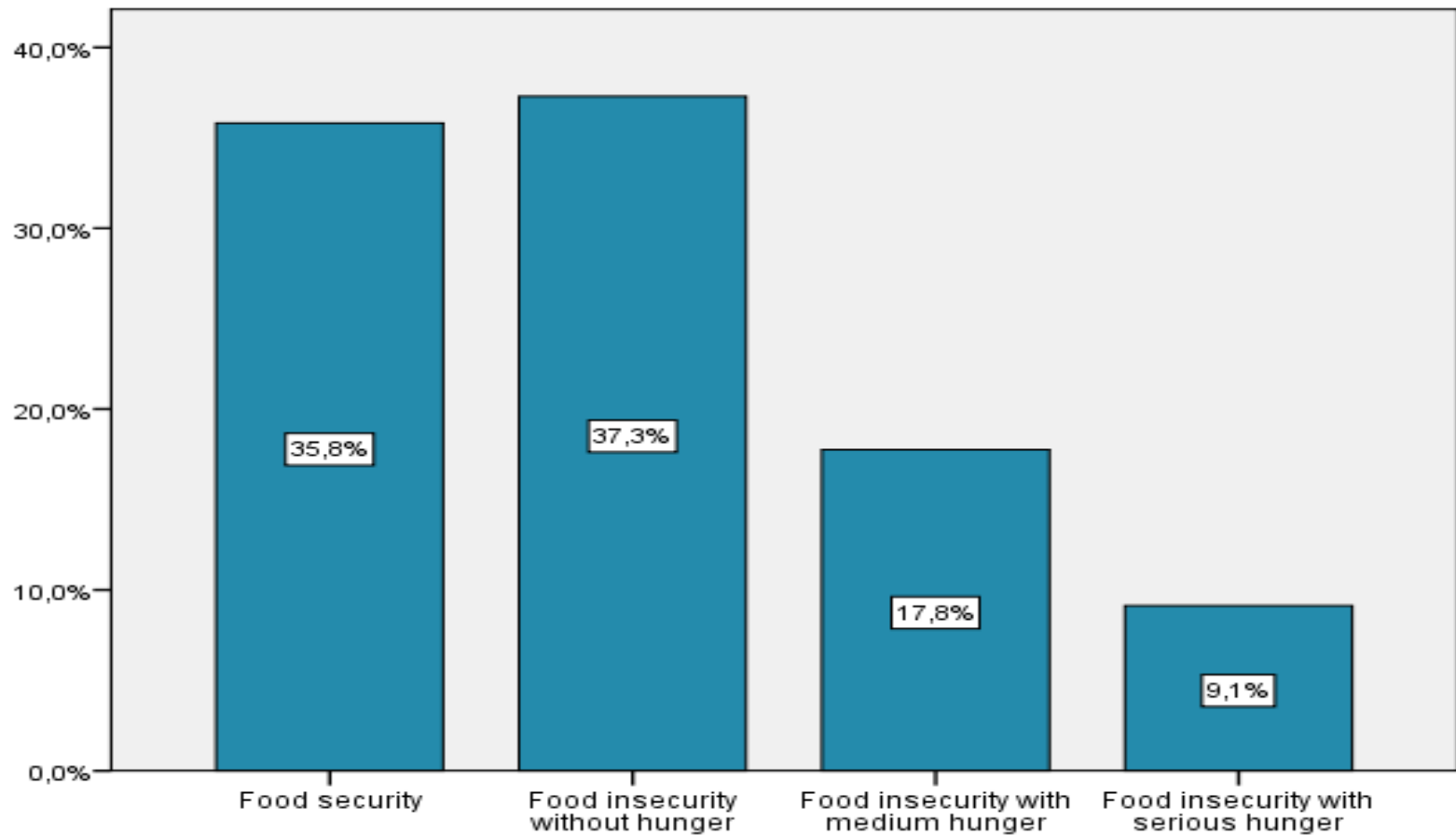


People at risk of poverty or social exclusion (% , 2005-2008, 2009-2013)
